


Alcatel One Touch Pop 7 Microphone Replacement

INTRODUCTION


In the case that your Alcatel One Touch Pop 7 Tablet is not registering sound when recording, their may be a problem with the microphone. This guide will show you how to replace the microphone within this device.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Tweezers (1)
- Soldering Iron (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover



 Begin by opening SD port cover as this is the best location to start prying.

Step 2




 Use the plastic opening tool to pry around the edges of the back cover until it pops off.

Step 3 — Microphone



 Disconnect battery by pulling up on the ZIF connector with precision tweezers for safety.

Step 4



 Remove the Microphone from it's slot with the precision tweezers.

Step 5



 Solder the wires off of the motherboard with a soldering iron while holding the wires with the precision tweezers. For information on how to solder safely and correctly go to this link: <u>How To Solder and</u> <u>Desolder Connections</u>
