


# Dell Inspiron 14 N4030 Memory Module Replacement



## INTRODUCTION


In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Memory Module.


#### Step 1 — Popping up the Memory Module



- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in Before You Begin.
- Use your fingertips to carefully spread apart the securing clips on each end of the memory-module connector until the module pops up.


#### Step 2 — Removing the Memory Module






• Remove the memory module from the memory-module connector.

### Step 3 — Align the Notch



 Align the notch in the **NEW** memory module with the tab in the memorymodule connector.

#### Step 4 — Sliding the Module



 Slide the memory module firmly into the slot at a 45-degree angle, and press the memory module down

until it clicks into place. If you do not hear the click, remove the memory module and reinstall it.

NOTE: If the memory module is not installed properly, the computer may not boot.
