- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tool (1)



PARTS:

- 250 GB SSD (1)
- 500 GB SSD (1)
- 1 TB SSD (1)
- 2 TB SSD (1)

Step 1 — Hard Drive





- Flip the laptop over.
- Using a Phillips #1 Screwdriver, unscrew the screw on the bottom left corner.

Step 2



 Using the iFixit Opening tool, loosen the hard drive cover.

Step 3



Remove the hard drive cover.

Step 4





Remove the hard drive by sliding it out.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
