


# **Disconnect Left-Over Logic Board Connectors**


Prerequisite-only guide to disconnect left-over logic board connectors during the upper case procedure.

## **TOOLS:**


- T3 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)
- Tweezers (1)

#### Step 1 — Disconnect the trackpad cable



- Use a T3 Torx driver to remove the two 1.4 mm screws securing the trackpad connector bracket.
- Remove the trackpad connector bracket.

### Step 2



• Use the flat end of a spudger to pry the trackpad cable connector up and out of its socket.

#### Step 3 — Disconnect the audio board cable



- Use a spudger to lift up the small locking flap on the sound board cable's <u>ZIF connector</u>.
- Slide the sound board cable out of the ZIF connector.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
