INTRODUCTION

Upgrading or replacing your CPU (Central Processing Unit) can help speed up and increase the power of your Chromebook. Be careful, as this is a crucial component of your computer.

TOOLS:

Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1) iFixit Opening Tool (1) Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover



- Place the laptop on a flat surface with the bottom side facing up.
- Remove the rubber feet from the bottom of the panel using your fingernails.
- Remove all the seven screws from the bottom panel.

Step 2



• Loosen the back cover panel using a spudger.

Step 3




• Once you work your way around, you can remove the panel.

Step 4 — CPU



• Remove the two Phillips screws on the fan.

Step 5



- Unplug the wires from the motherboard
- You can now see the CPU attached to the motherboard.
- The CPU cannot be removed from the motherboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
