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Step 1 — Alcatel One Touch Fierce Teardown



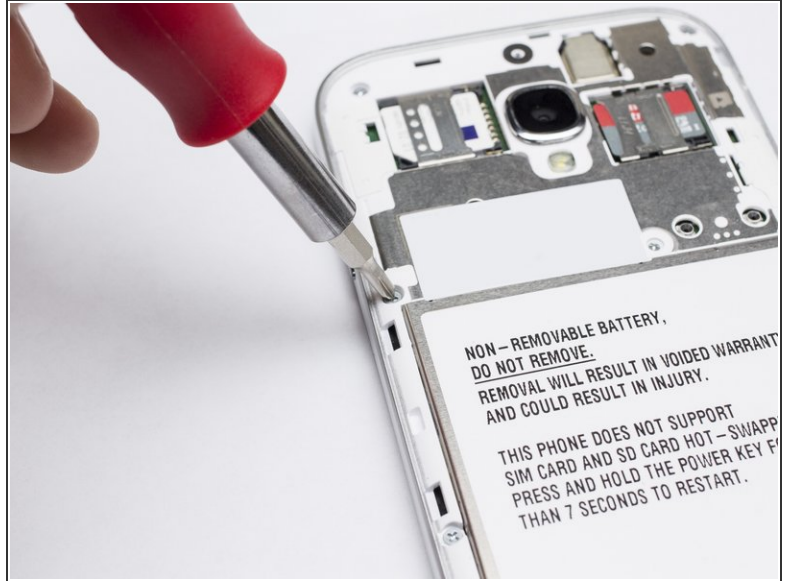
- Phillips #000 is highly recommended. As you can see i'm too broke for the iFixit equivalent.
- The iSesamo is also always handy.

Step 2



- This is the Metro PCS variant of the phone in a nice metallic silver color.
- The front of this particular device is water damaged and finger print damaged.

Step 3



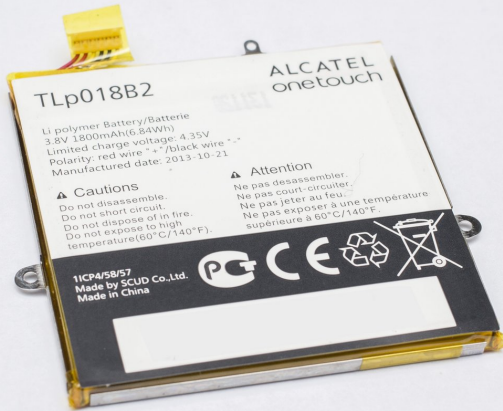
- With the back plastic removed.
- "DO NOT REMOVE"
- Challenge accepted

Step 4



- The second cover is removed. We now have a better look at the components.

Step 5



- The battery. Doesn't last very long.

Step 6



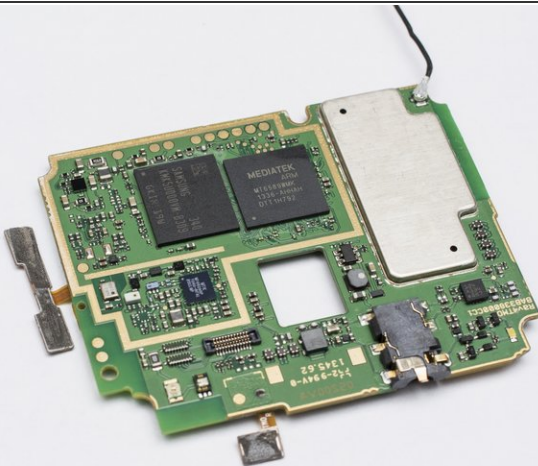
- The 5MP camera located on the back of the phone.

Step 7



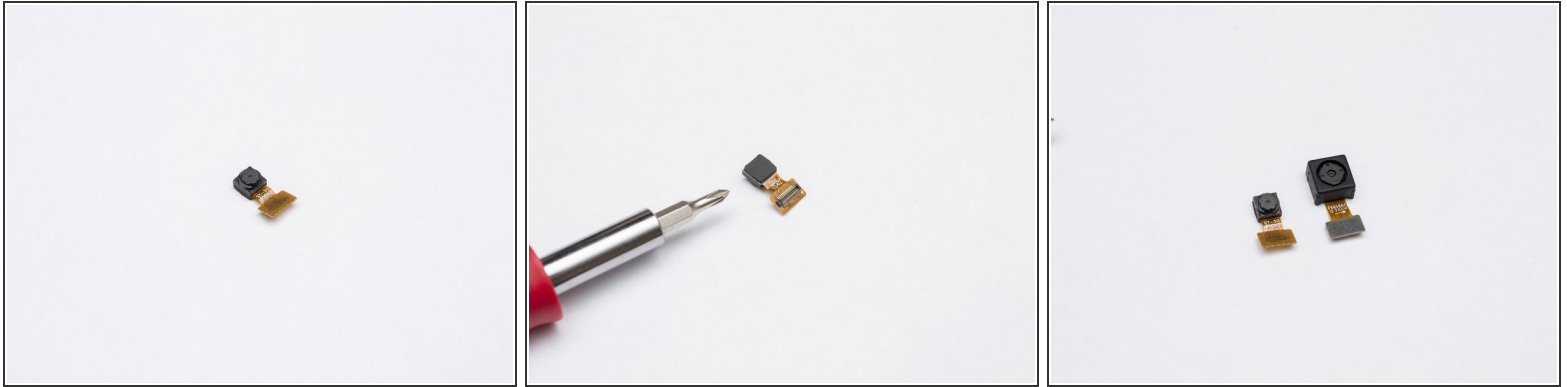
- The daughter board contains the Micro USB port

Step 8



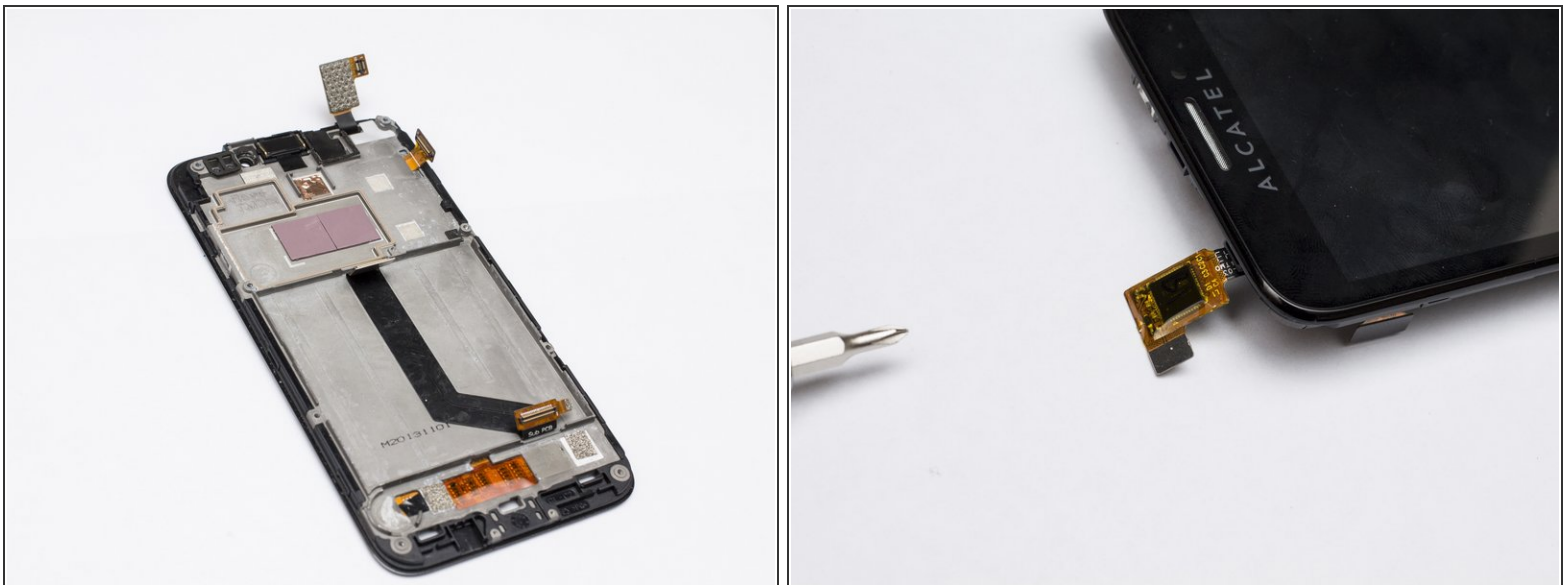
- The main PCB

Step 10



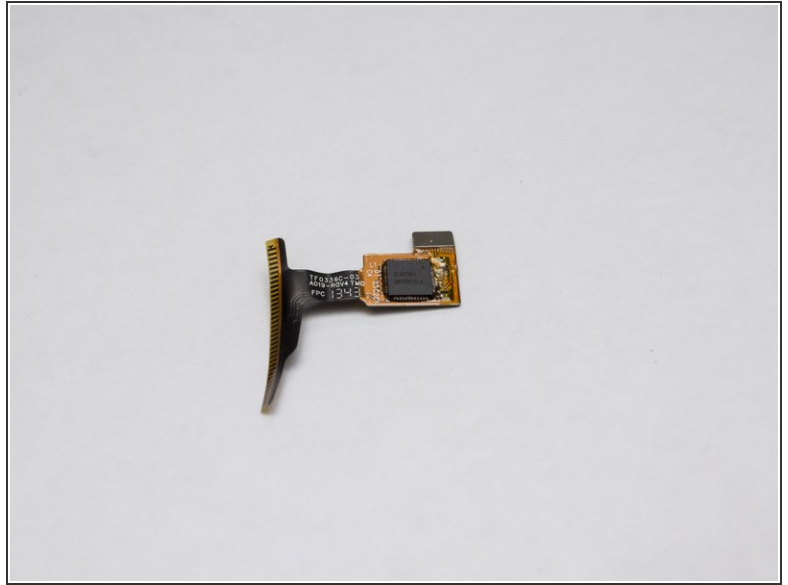
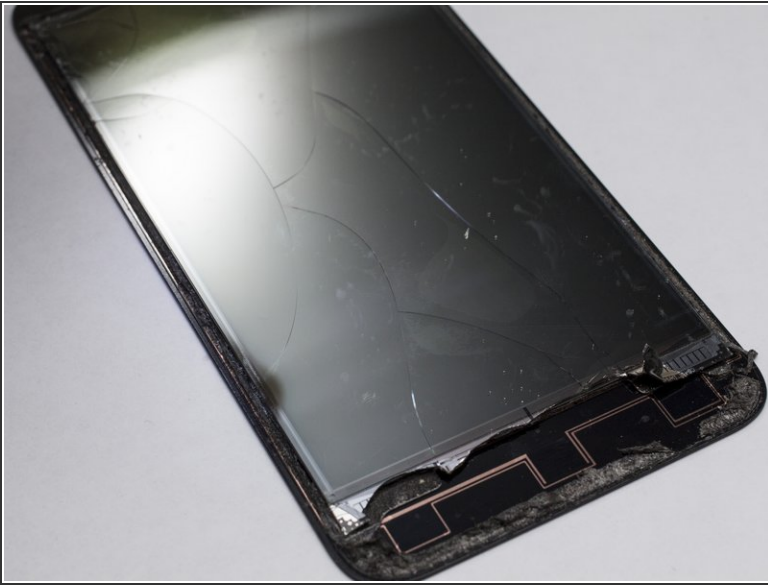
- The remains of the front panel

- Trying to remove the front panel assembly.
- It seemed to have quite a bit of adhesive.
- Luckily i have a good amount of picks available.
- Oh no, i think i hear cracking...

Step 12 — Shoot..



- Crap! i totally saw this coming.
- To avoid this use a heat gun to loosen the glue...not too much heat though.

- I now have a functional phone without an LCD screen.
