

HP Pavilion dv2000 Hard Drive Replacement

This guide will help you in removing the hard drive in the HP Pavilion dv2000.

INTRODUCTION

If you want to install a larger hard drive or if your hard drive isn't working, consider the steps in this guide to remove your current drive.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Hard Drive





- Flip your computer over, so that the underside of your computer is facing upward.
- Make sure your computer is powered down and unplugged from the charger before removing any components.
- Locate the hard drive casing on the bottom-right corner of your flipped computer.
- Remove the two 3.8mm screws with your <u>Phillips #00 Screwdriver</u> and carefully lift up and remove the hard drive casing.
 - (i) Screws on hard drive casing will remain in casing after being unscrewed.

Step 2







- After you lift off the hard drive casing, using your <u>Phillips #000 Screwdriver</u>, remove the two 3.6mm screws located on the right side of the hard drive.
- Using your fingers, carefully lift the lower right corner of your hard drive until it is removed from its housing.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
