


# Toshiba Satellite e205 Keyboard Replacement

### **INTRODUCTION**

The keyboard needs to be removed to access everything (hard drive, optical drive, RAM, motherboard).



## **TOOLS:**

- Spudger (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Battery




- With the battery away from you, slide the locking clips out.
  - (i) The left clip stays, the right clip is spring loaded.
- Slide the battery away from you.

## Step 2 — Keyboard




 Use a spudger to carefully pry up the keyboard screw cover.

#### Step 3



 Remove the two screws securing the keyboard to the chassis.

#### Step 4



- Carefully tilt the keyboard towards you and release the ribbon cables.
- Use a spudger if needed to release the latch. The latch slides out.
- The keyboard is now free and can be set aside.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
