


# **Motorola Defy Antenna Replacement**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide will go through the steps of replacing the antenna for the Motorola MB525 starting from the tear down of the phone to replacement of the antenna itself.

# TOOLS:

iFixit Opening Tool (1)

Tweezers (1)

T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Rear Case



 Using the screwdriver and the T-5 bit, unscrew the seven 5 mm screws around the outside of the phone.

### Step 2






• Remove the back cover of the phone by sliding the bottom black button to the unlock position and lifting it up.

### Step 3 — Battery



 Use a plastic opening tool to pry the battery out of the phone.

### Step 4 — Antenna






• Take the metal spudger and pry the black piece, where the sim card goes, off to get to the entire antenna.

# Step 5







• Pry the antenna off using the metal spudger and <u>tweezers</u> and replace with the new one.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
