INTRODUCTION

Steps to replace a broken speaker in the Nook HD+ tablet.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- 64 Bit Driver Kit (1)



PARTS:



Step 1 — Take off the Top Frame



- Wedge the plastic opening piece underneath the bottom left hand corner of the front frame
 - Pry open the front frame.


Step 2 — Remove the screws





Remove every visible screw tying the chassis to the bottom frame using a T-4 screwdriver bit.


Step 3 — Remove the Battery





- Carefully remove the bottom frame from center chassis.
- Detach the battery ribbon from the motherboard.
- Flip the center chaise onto the screen side with the hole positioned on the bottom right hand corner.

Step 4 — Unscrew the speaker



- In the bottom left hand corner remove the 3 screws that at attached to the speaker
- Disconnect the small red and black ribbon connected to the speaker from the white clip on the mother board.
- Replace old speaker with new speaker then follow instructions in reverse order to reassemble
