INTRODUCTION

If your Nokia (model 6085h) phone happens to malfunction, you most likely have a worn-out battery, in which requires replacement.

In this guide, you will be able to find out where the battery is located, and how to remove the battery safely.

Before beginning, make sure your device is powered off and disconnected from any external power source(s). Have the new battery ready and set to the side.

Step 1 — Battery



- Flip over the phone so that the back is facing up.
- Pressing your thumb against the back cover, slide the cover off of the phone.

Step 2



- Remove the phone's battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
