

# Samsung Galaxy Camera Lens and Motherboard Replacement

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
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tool (1)

# Step 1 — Screen



 Begin removing the 3/16" screws for the device.

# Step 2



 Turn the device and remove the additional 3/16" screws.

# Step 3



 Turn the device and remove the additional 3/16" screw.

# Step 4







Take the white cover plate off.

#### Step 5



- Using the plastic opening tools, pry open the camera from the bottom.
- This may require a moderate use of force because of the sealing glue.

#### Step 6



 Gently pull the connector away from the motherboard.

#### Step 7 — Lens and Motherboard



Unscrew the motherboard's screws.
There are 4 3/32" screws and 3
5/32" screws.

#### Step 8



 Unscrew the lens' screws. There are 1 black 4/32" screw, 3 3/16" black screws, and 2 white 5/32" screws.

# Step 9



 Pull these connectors away from motherboard.

# Step 10



 Lift the motherboard and lens out of the case.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
