INTRODUCTION

The optical drive is where CDs and DVDs are inserted and read in a laptop. Optical drives have various moving parts so they can malfunction or stop working properly. The optical drive can be removed easily in order to replace it.



TOOLS:

- Tweezers (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery





- Unplug the charging cable from the laptop and the wall. Failure to disconnect the charging cable could result in electric shock.
- Turn the laptop over.
- Locate the orange switch next to the battery.

Step 2







- Using a small tool such as tweezers or a pen, slide the orange switch completely to the left to unlock the battery.
- While holding the orange switch in place, lift the battery by the lip and pull it away from the laptop.

Step 3 — Optical Drive





- Locate the black screw just above the battery.
- Remove the black screw holding the optical drive in place by using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.

Step 4





Pull the optical drive free from the laptop.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
